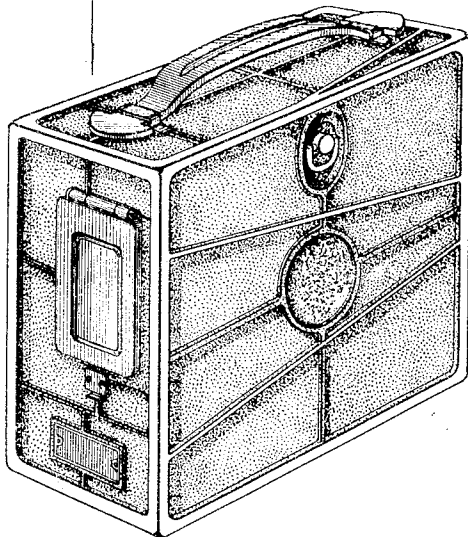
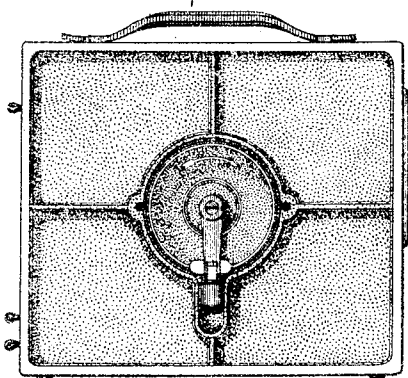

DESIGN FOR A CAMERA CASING.

Application filed May 4, 1923. Serial No. 6,053. Term of patent 14 years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, JULIEN TESSIER, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at Rochester, in the county of Monroe and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Camera Casings, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a perspective view of the camera casing showing my new design; and

Fig. 2 is a side elevation thereof.

In carrying out my design I prefer to

have that portion of the camera casing which is unshaded or stippled in the natural color of the metal of which the camera is made; here the silver color of aluminum. The shaded and stippled panels and other parts are of a contrasting shade to the outlining silver colored bands.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a camera casing, as shown and described.
